Create your own interactive story using the Ren'Py visual novel engine! Design a custom adventure using your own art and imagination. Recomended for students who have interest in making narrative games.

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Create your own game for your PC or phone with Construct 2! This program builds on game development fundamentals and teaches how math and science are used in making games.



Join us for an introduction to computer programming and game design! Spend a week exploring game design in one of two tracks, with Ren'Py or Construct 2. Gain experience using various design and programming tool kits with the help of instructors and mentors. Class time is broken up with icebreakers and team building activities. At the end of the workshop, students will be able to showcase their creation! Returning students may also participate as a student mentor. For lunches, pizza and snacks will be provided throughout the day. No previous experience is required!

The Teen Game Design Workshop is a free one-week day camp at Troy Middle School and has a limited number of spots which are filled on first come first serve basis.

Participants must attend all 5 days, which start at 9 a.m. and ends at 3 p.m. They may bring their own lunch, but pizza and light snacks will be provided. A parent or guardian must complete and sign this form, and an online recommendation from a guidance counselor, teacher or community leader is required to attend the camp. If a student is not on time the first day, they will forfeit their seat to a student on the waiting list.
